IMPORTANT RESERVATION INFORMATION

- 1. A Cub World Session consists of three days, three nights. Cost is \$265 if paid in full by May 31st. After May 31st cost is \$280. A Cub World Full Week is \$430 if paid in full by May 31st and \$460 after May 31st. **SAVE MONEY BY MAY 31**ST.
- 2. Site Reservations per site, per week (\$200.00) are **non-refundable**, but are transferrable for another camp week during same registered summer season. Hold-A-Place deposits are applied towards the Pack's total cost to attend camp. **Units are asked to fill the site requested at least** ³/₄ **full of site capacity**. If Unit is unable to do so, there is a possibility your unit will be asked to share or move to another site.
- 3. A \$40.00 per week or single session camper deposit is due by MARCH 31st. This camper deposit is required for the total number of youth your Pack is projecting to attend Cub World (Camper Deposit Example: Pack #2 is projecting 5 youth and 4 adults for session 1A or 1B. Therefore, 5 youth @ \$40.00 (camper deposit) = \$200.00 due by March 31st.)
- 4. The Leadership policy of the Boy Scouts of America **requires each unit to have a minimum of two (2) adult leaders in camp at all times**, one of whom must be 21 years of age or older and trained. Packs that cannot provide the required adult leadership should contact Camping Services to discuss the potential of teaming up with another Pack from your District or Borough to meet the standard for leadership policy. All Tiger Cubs must attend with an adult partner and must be at least six (6) years of age.
- The participation of Den Chief(s) is acceptable as additional leadership. A "Den Chief" is a <u>currently registered Boy Scout</u> (at least First Class in rank who is Den Chief Trained) who has been approved by the Cubmaster and/or the Pack Committee. The Den Chief ratio is 1:8. All Den Chiefs will pay the Den Chief Fee of \$110 per session or \$220 per week. If the ratio is not met then the Den Chief pays the camper fee. **No Pack is excused from this ratio**.
- All adults and Scouts attending Cub World must bring an <u>official completed Annual Health and Medical Record</u> <u>form signed and stamped by their personal physician</u>. It is imperative the Medical Forms have all requested information filled in. All medical examinations must be within the past twelve (12) months. Forms can be downloaded from our website bsa-gnyc.org. <u>It is important to make a copy of your stamped medical form for your file</u>.
- 7. To accommodate everyone, reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis with completed applications and fees.
- 8. If you do not hear from Camping Services within two weeks of making a reservation, please call us at (212) 651-3073 to confirm your reservation. You may email us at camping@bsa-gnyc.org.
- 9. It is highly <u>recommended that leaders make photocopies of this form as well as any other applications and receipts of payments for your own records.</u>
